Limitations and Conditions:

1. Operate in accordance with SPW Flight Manual Supplements FMS354301, Revision 1, FMS 354302, Revision 2, FMS354311, Revision 1 or FMS354312, Revision 2, all dated July 16, 2010, all TCCA approved September 22, 2010, or later approved Transport Canada revision as applicable to the aircraft model and gross weight configuration installed.
2. Maintain in accordance with SPW Maintenance Manual Supplement and Instructions for Continued Airworthiness MMS354301, Revision 2, dated August 16, 2010, or later Transport Canada approved revisions.
3. This STC does not approve the use of the 3500 Aerocet floats for use on model 182R
4. The installer must determine whether this design change is compatible with previously approved modifications.
5. If the holder agrees to permit another person to use the certificate to alter the product, the holder must give the other person written evidence of that permission.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
